**THOMAS M. HILDEBRAND'S MOTION TO REOPEN THE RECORD TO ACCEPT RESULTS  
OF THE PJM STUDY REQUESTED BY THE MARYLAND PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION  
AND MOTION TO TAKE JUDICIAL NOTICE OF TESTIMONY TO MD PSC**

On June 5, 2008, the Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC) received a motion filed by respondent "Virginia's Commitment," (Dominion Virginia Power and TrAIL Case # PUE-2007-00031 and 33) to reopen the case to accept recent results of a PJM study requested by the MD PSC. On June 6, 2008, Dominion and TrAILCo filed a joint Response and Motion to Strike ("Response"), in which they opposed the Motion and asked that portions of the post-hearing briefs of Piedmont and Virginia's Commitment based upon the May 2008 RPM auction be stricken. On June 9, 2008, Virginia SCC Hearing Examiner Alexander F. Skirpan, Jr, issued the following ruling:

*Based on the pleadings, I find that the record should be reopened and a hearing convened to receive testimony and argument related to the May 2008 RPM and the latest information available regarding the need for the proposed transmission line.*

On June 10, 2008, the Board of Supervisors of Fauquier County, Board of Supervisors of Prince William County, Piedmont Environmental Council, and Power-Line Landowners Alliance replied in support of and supplemented the motion to reopen. In connection with this reopening of the record, Joint Respondents ask that the Hearing Examiner to take judicial notice of the May 21, 2008 PSC MD transcript of PJM's Mr. Kormos' testimony to the PSC MD Commissioners concerning Mr. Kormos' presentation on the same date.

For the reasons cited in the attached filings, I respectfully request the WV Commission to reopen the evidentiary record in the WV case to receive the latest and best available information regarding the need for the TrAIL line. I also request the Commission take judicial notice of the aforementioned testimony accompanying this report and given to the MD PSC. For completeness, I've attached the following documents:

- 1) Virginia's Commitment Motion to Reopen (includes PJM's study results)
- 2) VA SCC ruling granting motion to reopen the case
- 3) Joint Respondent support and supplement requesting judicial notice be taken (includes testimony on report to MD PSC)
